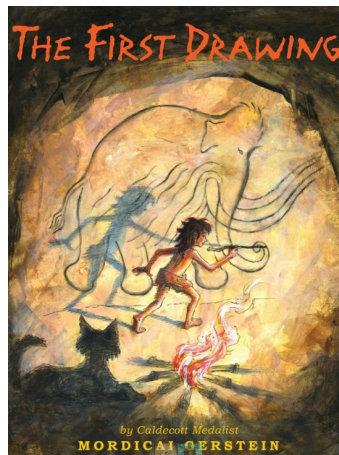
Hedgehogs Class Update

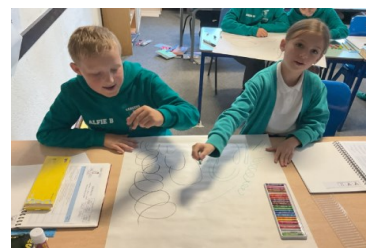
Otter Class Update
